Off Duty Plain Clothes Survival

Instructor: Rodney Sanchez

This program will explore the difficulties encountered by officers engaging in a deadly force encounter while off-duty or on assignment in plain clothes

Not only does the officer have to deal with the threat he or she encounters, but also the risk posed in dealing with responding uniformed officers. Students will demonstrate the concept of proper decision making utilizing available tactics based on the use of force continuum. This course will encompass classroom lecture, range exercises and scenario development. **Rodney Sanchez** is a lead instructor for a major state law enforcement agency and owner of the Hard Target Security Group.

Student Requirements: Wraparound eye protection, ear protection, off-duty handgun with 3 magazines, plain clothes holster, BDU/raid jacket and 300 rounds of ammunition. Soft body armor is recommended.

Target Focused Fire

Instructor: Jack Conahan

Utilizing techniques taught by the FBI prior to 1981 with enhancements developed by the instructor, it is possible to hit targets at close to intermediate ranges without using handgun sights. Commonly called "point shooting", in reality, "target-focused fire" is a specific form of aimed fire. The course includes stances and draw technique which can enhance, but are not essential to, satisfactory results.

Jack Conahan was a Special Agent of the FBI for over 25 years with assignments to Special Operations, Undercover operations, SWAT Assault Team, Sniper Team and Sniper Team Leader as well as criminal and counterintelligence investigations. As an FBI Firearms Instructor he provided training in handgun, shotgun, rifle and sub-machinegun to federal, state and local officers, including the USMC Guard Detachment at Camp David.

Target Focused Fire continued....

Student Requirements: Handgun, duty or concealment holster & belt, cap with visor or brim, eye & ear protection, 150 rounds of ammunition.

Always Cheat Always Win: Fast & Furious Rifle Shooting at Pistol Distance

Instructor: Michael Boyle

A rifle affords the law enforcement with a means of hitting a threat beyond practical handgun range. It is equally important to recognize that rifles can be extremely efficient conflict resolution tools in close quarters as well. Without question, a rifle delivers better stopping potential, superior hit probability and faster threat acquisition than a pistol. A rifle can also be a very strong psychological deterrent to individuals who might otherwise be predisposed to violent behavior. This block of instruction will focus on the use of a rifle in relatively close quarters. The emphasis will be the delivery of fast, accurate and shots in realistic time frames. **Mike Boyle** is recently retired Captain with the New Jersey Division of Fish & Wildlife, Bureau of Law Enforcement. He has over 25 years of experience as a police firearms instructor. Mike remains active as a police academy instructor and range master and serves as a director on the IALEFI Board.

Student Requirements: semi-automatic .223 cal rifle or pistol caliber carbine with sling 3 magazines for same and 250 rounds of ammunition. Handgun with 50 rounds of ammunition. Special requirements: 2 pieces of high vertical cover.

Ballistic Workshop: Ammunition Performance & Stopping Potential- What Makes A Good Police Service Round?

Instructor: Mike Shovel

Is penetration more important than expansion? Are larger calibers always better? These and other questions will be addressed in this program. Attendees will have an opportunity to test their service ammunition in ballistic gelatin. At the conclusion of the training, participants will be able to make sound recommendations relative to the selection of defensive ammunition. **Mike Shovel** is the national Sales manager for CorBon/Glaser and has over 30 years experience as a competitive shooter. He is active in the design and test and evaluation of ammunition and is the designer of the .500 Special cartridge and the innovative CorBon DPX line.
