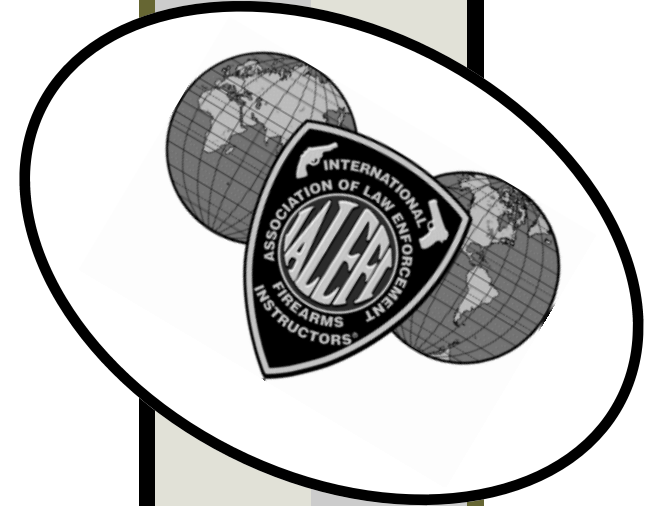

Courses of Instruction:

Quick Draw Ground Defense Systems Joe Maffei, Integrated Martial Development Center

Course description: This block of instruction will provide the student with a viable means of defending and accessing their firearms during a violent ground fight. Many confrontations, involving law enforcement officers end up on the ground. Techniques taught are designed to work against opponents who are much bigger and stronger.

Instructor Bio: Joe Maffei has been a practitioner of defensive tactics and martial arts for more than 30 years. He operates his own training facility in Waltham, MA, he has coached students to two world titles in mixed martial

arts. Joe has also trained law enforcement officers from state, local, military, and various elite federal agencies

Student requirements: Duty belt, inert training gun (if available) ankle holster (if available) training knife.

Urban Rifle Mike Rodriguez

Course Description: Of late there has been considerable interest in the use of rifles by law enforcement personnel. This course will focus on the use of the semi-automatic, magazine fed rifle by both the patrol officer and tactical specialist. The emphasis will be on the delivery of accurate shots in the shortest possible time frame. Participants will fire from a variety of positions, at distances typical of confrontation in urban environments.

Instructor Bio: Detective Mike Rodriguez recently returned from a deployment in Iraq with SEAL Team 5. He has over 12 years of military service and has been employed as a law enforcement officer for 20 years in New York City and New Jersey. Mike has been certified as a firearms instructor in both New York and New Jersey. He is currently a member of his departments High Risk Entry Team.

Student requirements: Rifle, 3 magazines and 250 rounds of ammunition. IALEFI Corporate Sponsor Sturm, Ruger will be supplying a limited number of the Mini-14 rifles for the course.

Managing Low Light Threats Mike Boyle

Course Description: Most police action shooting continue to occur under less than optimum light conditions. Unfortunately, traditional police training does not adequately address the most likely anticipated encounter. Human performance in low light, flashlight techniques, tactical technological innovations and successful exercises will be covered. An optional low light live fire session will be conducted the evening of the first day.

Instructor Bio: Mike Boyle is recently retired Captain with the New Jersey Division of Fish & Wildlife, Bureau of Law Enforcement. He has over 25 years of experience as a police firearms instructor and has taught extensively on the subject of low light. Mike remains active as a police academy instructor and range master and serves as a director on the IALEFI Board.

Student requirements: Pen and notebook, if participating in the live fire session, 150 rounds of ammunition, duty pistol and flashlight.

The Isosceles Grip Dennis Carroll

Course Description: The modified Isosceles (thumbs forward) grip is the preferred grip for competition and becoming the preferred grip for law enforcement and military units. Goals and objectives of this course will cover the development of the grip, shooter/tactical advantages, how to establish the grip and how to teach the grip.

Instructor Bio: Dennis Carroll is a retired Lieutenant from the Schaumburg Illinois Police Department and is currently an adjunct instructor for the Sig-Sauer Academy. He also serves as a Director on the IALEFI Board.

Student requirements: Pistol with 4-6 magazines, duty/tactical holster, magazine pouches and 300 rounds of ammunition.
